<b>1) Mission &amp; Values:</b> Does this proposal align with our purpose & values?			
<b>2) Environmental Impact:</b> Has this project considered its environmental impact?			
<b>3) Social Impact:</b> Does the project have a clear focus for its proposed community benefit?			
<b>4) Place:</b> Will the project add to the physical, social, or cultural experience of our area / have a positive visible impact?			
<b>5) Ownership / Community-Led:</b> How have they been involved in developing the project? How will our community be involved?			
<b>6) Value for Money?</b> Does this project offer good value for money?			
<b>7) Learning &amp; Skills:</b> Does this project include opportunities for community members to learn and develop new skills?			
<b>8) Collaboration and Partnerships:</b> Has the proposal considered other skills and experience available in the area to strengthen their project and its impact locally?			
<b>9) Experience / Capability:</b> Does the applicant have the relevant skills, knowledge and experience to safely & effectively deliver this project?			
<b>10) Sustainability:</b> Will the project offer a long term opportunity for community engagement?			
<b>11) Legacy:</b> What will have changed if we fund this project? Will that impact last longer than the project?			
<b>12) Creative West End:</b> How do you plan to work with Creative West End to prompt wider community impact? Does it meet one of our 4 outcome areas?
